

## GUEST PROGRAM

### SUNDAY EVENING

Attendees and Guests as well will enjoy the traditional Reception. The reception will include entertainment, snacks and beverages. This is a great opportunity to renew old acquaintances and make new ones.

### MONDAY

Buses will pick guests up, after continental breakfast, at the Galt House at 9:00 am. The tour will showcase outstanding attractions and architecture, giving you a glimpse of both the heritage and current quality of life in the Derby City.

Highlights of the tour include the Downtown area featuring the Humana building, Kentucky Center for the Arts, Aegon Center, Actors Theatre of Louisville, and the Ohio River. The third largest collection of Victorian Mansions in the U.S. is found in the Old Louisville neighborhood, near the University of Louisville campus.

Next you will share the mystery and beauty of glass, while visiting GLASSWORKS, an attraction that you will truly enjoy. You will stop at the hot glass studios, flame working studios and the cold glass working studios of Architectural Glass Art. Glassworks Gallery will prove exciting for any glass enthusiast. Watch resident artists, glass blowers, flame workers, cutters and designers create magnificent pieces of glass art.

Finally, the motorcoachs will drop the group off and end the tour at the 4<sup>th</sup> Street Live! Entertainment district, where lunch will be on your own. There are many restaurants from which to choose and this is a great starting point to walk to the different museums and attractions on Main Street. 4<sup>th</sup> Street Live is in easy walking distance to the Galt House and there is also a trolley that makes frequent stops at the downtown hotels and museums.

Monday evening will feature a tour of the Ohio River on the Belle of Louisville. The Belle of Louisville is an early 20<sup>th</sup> century steam powered paddle wheel river boat and will tour the Ohio River for approximately 2 hours. The Belle boards at 6:30, sails at 7:00 and is just across the street from the Galt House. This tour is for all attendees including guests.

### TUESDAY

Tour buses will pick up guests, after continental breakfast, at 9:15 and will take you to the Kentucky Derby Museum for a 30 minute historic walking tour of Churchill Downs, a 17 minute showing of the "Greatest Race", tour the gift shop and see more of the museum. A buffet lunch will be served in the Derby Café at the museum. Next you will visit the Louisville Stoneware for a tour where you can see how the pottery is made and visit the gift shop. The Louisville Stoneware was established in 1815. Skilled artisans create beautiful dinnerware, bakeware, serving pieces and collectibles that can be enjoyed and cherished for generations. You will get back to the Galt House in time to get ready for the evening events.
